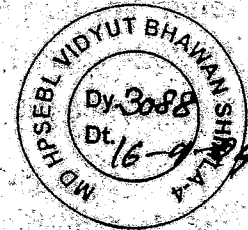



It has further informed that similar activities could easily be managed remotely through e-mail or written communication.

In view of the above, it is requested to issue necessary instructions/directions to all the Departments under your control to send a single representative to Delhi for Supreme Court cases that too, if absolutely necessary. The O/o District Attorney HP Legal Cell, New Delhi will provide all the judgments of the various courts located at New Delhi or other documents without any delay.

Subject: Concern regarding unnecessary travel of officials in Delhi for Supreme Court Matters .

Respected Sir,

It is respectfully submitted that it has come to the notice of this office that two to three representatives from various Districts of Himachal Pradesh are traveling to Delhi for the follow up a single case or for some other trivial work. Even today, a group of three officials (SDO, JE and Senior Assistant) arrived from Mechanical Sub-Division, HP PWD, District Mandi to collect a single copy of a judgment. This office was not even aware of their intent of visit, either telephonically, by letter, or by email. Such practice reflects a waste of time, resources, and public funds of the State Government.

The task of obtaining a judgment copy or similar activities could easily be managed remotely through email or written communication. Additionally, it has been observed that some employees extends their stay in Delhi for several days under the pretext of Supreme Court related work, even when they have no official duties to perform.

In light of this, I respectfully request that directives be issued to all District-level offices to send a single representative to Delhi for Supreme Court cases that too, if absolutely necessary. Alternatively, they can communicate with the Legal Cell via email, letter, or telephone. The Legal Cell always responds promptly and provides the required information or documents without any delay. This will help the State Government to save on Travel Expenses and make better use of resources.
