

Vendor Declaration for Compliance with PM Surya Ghar Yojana in State of Himachal Pradesh

1. **Declaration on Project Limits:** The vendor may undertake a maximum of five (5) projects or 30 kW of capacity, whichever is higher, concurrently. No additional systems may be booked until the previously booked systems have been installed. Each system must be installed within 60 days of its booking.
2. **Declaration on PV Module and Inverter Specifications:** The vendor is required to provide the consumer with detailed information on the number of photovoltaic (PV) modules installed, including the make of the modules, their compliance with Approved List of Models and Manufacturers (ALMM) standards, their capacities, and the inverter ratings. This information, along with the contract between the vendor and the consumer, must be uploaded to the designated portal.
3. **Advisory and Declaration on System Performance:** The Performance Ratio (PR) of the plant must be at least 75% at the time of commissioning by DISCOM or its authorized agency. The vendor must provide a radiation sensor with a valid calibration certificate from any NABL or international laboratory on a returnable basis at the time of commissioning or testing of the plant. The vendor must maintain the PR of the plant throughout the warranty period, which is 5 years from the date of commissioning.
4. **Vendor Commitment on Warranty Period and Service Centres:** The vendor is required to specify the duration and number of days needed to address repairs or any faults within the warranty period. The vendor must address the complaints within 48 working hours. The vendor must have a service centre with a toll-free number for beneficiaries to call in case of complaints. Additionally, the vendor must establish a service centre in Himachal Pradesh to ensure prompt and efficient service.
5. **Declaration on Bidirectional Meter Costs:** The rate quoted by the vendor must include the cost of the bi-directional net meter/check meter and comply with the benchmark cost per kilowatt (kW). No additional charges may be levied on the consumer.
6. **Advisory on Benchmark Cost and Compliance:** Both consumers and vendors are advised not to charge or accept costs exceeding the benchmark rates as per the guidelines of MNRE.

Non-compliance with these guidelines may result in blacklisting.
