

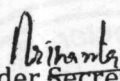

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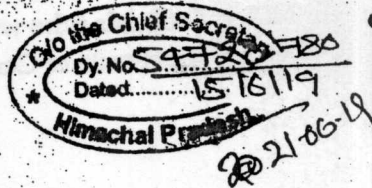

Dear Sir,

As you are aware that the next Population Census is due in 2021. The Houselisting and Housing Census (Phase-I) would be undertaken in one month's time during the period April-September, 2020 as per the convenience of the State/Union Territory. The Population Enumeration (Phase-II) would be conducted during 9th -28th February, 2021. The Census is conducted as per the provisions of Census Act, 1948.

2. As a preparatory step towards Census 2021, a Pre-test is conducted encompassing all facets of Census Operations as per the Act. The idea is to check the questions proposed to be canvassed, methodological changes in the census process, logistic arrangements, processing of data etc. Mobile App is being used for the first time for collection of data. A web-based portal for monitoring of field activities will also be tested during the Pre-test.

3. The Pre-test for Census 2021 is proposed to be conducted in selected areas of all the States/UTs during August-September, 2019. The Government of India notification for conducting Pre-test, under Section 17-A of the Census Act, shall be published shortly. A copy of same will be sent to you separately with the request to re-publish this in State/UT Gazette.

4. I am enclosing herewith the list of the sample areas selected for Pre-test. These areas have been selected by Directorate of Census Operations (DCO) in consultation with the Nodal Department of your State. The Pre-test being a full dress rehearsal, requires engagement of teachers, government/ semi-government officials as Census enumerators/ supervisors, and Tahasildar(s)/B.D.O.(s)/Mamlatdar(s)/Executive Officer etc. as Charge Officers. To simulate the full process, it is proposed that 25-50% of the Enumerators in the Pre-test should be females.

5. The State Directorate of Census Operation will be communicating the exact requirement of personnel, area wise, for the Pre-test. I shall be grateful if you could kindly issue instructions to the nodal Department in charge of Census in the State/UT to coordinate the activities of Pre-test. The officials deployed for Census work in the

Pre-test including training, will be treated 'on duty' during the period of Pre-test and will draw their salary from the parent department. However, an honorarium will be paid to all the State Government officers/officials who will be deployed for this work, the details of which will be provided by Directorate of Census Operations (DCO) later.
