Subject:- Feasibility reports for Online Single Window Portal proposal-Guidelines thereof.

Sir,

As you are aware that the proposal for setting up an industrial undertaking or expansion of existing undertaking is to be submitted by the unit through online Single Window Portal of HP Govt. and all the clearances are required to be issued to the unit through Single Window Portal including the power commitments for the load requisitioned in the proposal.

This office has been designated as Nodal Office for sending the supply of power arrangement through online mode on the proposal submitted by the industrial unit. As per Sales Circular No. 26/2019 issued on 28.01.2019, the feasibility reports are sought from the field units i.e. ED and ES Division Sr.E.E. or concerned Circles whichever is received earlier due to time limit of 5 days setup by HP Govt. to intimate the comments. The comments in respect of power availability at 66 kV and above is to be uploaded after approval of Director (Tech), HPSEBL.

It has been observed by the competent authority that the feasibility reports are not being submitted by the field units (ES or ED) after proper study of loading position of Sub-Stations /lines, the loads already committed and yet to be released resulting in load constraints in releasing the loads to the consumers.

In view of above, competent authority has approved the following :-

- 1) The arrangement for supply of power shall be invariably discussed and got approved by MD, HPSEBL before uploading on Single Window Portal.
- 2) The Loading capacity status and constraints of EHV Sub-Station and line should be complied by CE(SP) and CE(SO) and data should be invariably updated on fortnightly basis. The same shall be uploaded on HPSEBL Website. The decision on commitment of power shall be taken based on the available data and such data shall be referred by CE(Comm.) while preparing the comments on availability of power.

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- 3) The field units (ES and Operation) shall intimate the quantum of load already committed from the Sub-Station /line and accordingly the arrangement of supply of power. However being single distribution licensee, no connection be invariably refused rather arrangement of new /upgradation of sub-station be intimated. The arrangement be intimated to this office within three days in order to comply the time frame fixed by Govt.

The above instructions may be followed in letter and spirit.
