Interim Order

(Previous date of hearing in the complaint was Nil.)

M/s Him Teknoforge Ltd., Village Kishanpura, Post Office Manpura, Tehsil Nalagarh, being a consumer of HPSEBL, has filed a complaint through authorized representative Sh. Rakesh Bansal on 19.04.2022. The Complaint is accompanied with an Application for Interim Relief requesting therein to stay operation of impugned Demand Notice dated 12.06.2017 issued by the HPSEBL. From the record, it is seen that advance copies have been sent through India Post to the Respondent parties. In the complainant, the consumer has placed on record aforementioned impugned Demand Notice issued by the HPSEBL to the consumer demanding therein payment of Rs. 48,46,200/- only, while the complainant consumer in his complaint is disputing entire amount of Rs. 1,67,85,000/- towards infrastructure Development Charges. In the Application it is stated that the amount of Rs. 1,24,38,800/- (being Rs 1,19,38,800/- stated to be paid in the year 2012 and earlier + Rs 5,00,000/- stated to be paid in the year 2017) stands deposited with the Respondent which is more than 1/3rd amount as is

required under the HPERC Regulations to be deposited. However, from the perusal of impugned Demand Notice dated 12.06.2017, it is seen that the Demand Notice dated 12.06.2017 is only for a balance amount of Rs. 48,46,200/-. This Demand Notice also speaks of an Undertaking/Affidavit furnished by the consumer Complainant at the time of sanction of load / release of load and on this condition load was released by the HPSEBL. It is evident from record that the impugned Demand Notice is not for Rs.1,67,85,000/- but is for Rs. 48,46,200/- only and this is a balance amount demanded by the HPSEBL to be paid by the Complainant . No other Demand Notice of the HPSEBL is under challenge in the Complaint.

The Complaint is admitted. Complainant is directed to deposit 1/3rd of the amount of Rs.48,46,200/- demanded vide impugned Demand Notice dated 12.06.2017 which amounts to Rs. 16,15,400/-. This amount will be deposited within 10 days i.e. on or before 4th May, 2022. In the mean time operation of impugned Demand Notice of Rs.48,46,200/- shall be Stayed however, subject to deposit of the 1/3rd amount as aforesaid. The Respondent Board is directed to file the para-wise Reply to the Complaint within three weeks time of this Order with advance copy to the Complainant.

Notice be issued to both the parties through registered post.
