The above-mentioned committee will make recommendations within 15 day's positively from the date of issue of this order taking into account:-

1. The existing norms prescribed by the HPSEBL vide this office order No.101 dated 31-12-1979 and order No.57 dated 09-07-1991 in view creation of new Electrical Sub-Division has been fixed with crossing of consumers count above 7000. However, with passage of time, now it has been observed that with the improvement of infra-structure such as connectivity,

transportation, etc.; the deliverable jobs in Sub division offices are taking lesser time. Further, with improvement of above mentioned facilities, the consumers have also been facilitates by way of easier movement to sub division offices for resolving any type of grievances etc. The initial consumer count of 7000 was fixed during the year 1991 was kept keeping in mind the fact that consumers do not have to visit very long for its works in a Sub division office. At older time the transportation facilities were very poor and there were no facilities available viz a viz technology facilities. The consumers at that time had to travel to sub division's offices even for deposit of bills. With the new facilities of on line payment. On line applications for new connection available, the physical movement of person to sub division has decreased drastically. The same also applies for caring out the normal billing of consumers in various areas. With improvement of transportation facilities, the movability of HPSEBL employee has also increased and thus resultantly a meter reading of more number of consumers can be easily achieved as compared to earlier time. Subsequently , a Circle should normally consists of 5 Divisions and a Division should normally consists of 5 Sub-Divisions under its control which is required to be framing the new yard stick and staffing norms for Operation Sub-Division/Division and Circle.

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2. Annual input Energy.
 3. Number and category of Consumers, being /to be served.
 4. Geographical area, future expansion and challenges.
 5. Consumer Satisfaction.
 6. Maintenance of reliable and quality power, execution and supervision of capital work.
 7. Introduction of latest State of Technology , Technological intervention for enhancing operational efficiency, effective communicable system throughout HPSEBL for running the Computer related activities with specific focus on suitable pooling of resource for various activities i/c maintenance of EHV/HT/LT lines, Sub-Stations.
 8. Impact of IT initiative like online billing , ERP, SAP online payment option through Bank, Post Office, KIOSK, e-Wallets, RTGs, NEFT, adherence to billing cycle and standard of performance.

9. Any other parameter/indicator which the committee seems relevant for this purpose.

The above committees will submit its report/recommendation to this office within 15 day's positively from the date of issue of this order , so that the report /recommendation could be placed before the competent authority for consideration and decision.
