(Interim Order)

The complaint dated 02.08.2022 was received in this office on 10.08.2022. The office of CGRF had raised some objections on the complaint and documents filed particularly with regard to legibility of supporting documents and with regard to matter being sub-judice in court as stated in on Annexure (C2-colly) dated March 16, 2022. The same was communicated to the complainant. The Complainant in compliance filed an application with regard to observation made by the CGRF vide letter dated 17.08.2022. The application so filed along with the documents are unverified and without supporting affidavit to authenticate the documents supplied. The Complainant consented to file the authenticated documents.

In view of above submissions, Complainant is directed to file documents/ annexures duly certified, along with affidavit on or before 30.09.2022 with advance copy to Respondent Board and where true typed copies are filed such be self attested. The Complainant pressed for allowing the Interim Application for relief filed for staying the disconnection of electricity. On examination of Interim Application accompanying the main complaint, this Forum observes that the Respondent Board has not issued any Notice for disconnection in accordance with Sub-Section 56(1) of the Electricity Act, 2003 and the extant Regulations and

neither has such copy of the Notice been placed on record by the Complainant with the Application filed for interim relief. Also, this Forum cannot ascertain from record as to against what has the stated amount of Rs. 6, 02,910/- been deposited, such amount nowhere having been ordered to be paid by this Forum. In such eventuality no Interim Relief can be granted nor any directions can be imparted. The Application for Interim Stay is accordingly disposed of. However, it is made clear that the Respondent Board may continue to take actions in accordance with extant Regulations on matter and in case of any coercive action by the Respondent, the Complainant is given liberty to approach this Forum for relief. Reply to be filed by Respondent HPSEBL on or before 30.09.2022.
