Dear Sir,

As you are aware, 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' (AKAM) is an initiative of the Government of India to celebrate and commemorate 75 years of progressive India and the glorious history of its people, culture and achievements. This Mahotsav is dedicated to the people of India who have not only been instrumental in bringing India thus far in its revolutionary journey but also in shaping India's social, cultural, political and economic identity.

2. National Implementation Committee (NIC), chaired by Hon'ble Home Minister, in its meeting held on 11th October, 2021, approved the events to be conducted for celebration of "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav" and the same has been reviewed by Committee of Secretaries (COS) on 27th October 2021. The Committee *inter-alia* approved the event - "Good Governance Week" for the period of 20-26th December, 2021 to be celebrated by Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions as the lead Ministry. Event details are annexed, as discussed with Secretary, DARPG on 03.11.2021.

3. In this regard, on the occasion of this milestone celebration, Hon'ble Minister of Home Affairs may be requested to be the Chief Guest of honour. Other VIPs who may be requested to grace the occasion may be Shri Rajiv Kumar, Vice Chairman, NITI Ayog. Accordingly, you may instruct the concerned officers to get the event curated in collaboration with the concerned related Ministries /Departments.

4. In order to ensure that the events are projected as part of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM) Abhiyan, some basic strategies may be observed:

- I) All posters to carry AKAM logo prominently:
 - i. Size of the AKAM logo to be bigger than any other logo used in the communication.
 - ii. AKAM logo to be placed at the top centre of the poster, backdrop, advertisement etc.
 - iii. The event must carry any of these lines in all communications -
 - An Amrit Mahotsav initiative by the Ministry/Department/State Government
 - A special initiative of the Ministry/Department/State Government as part of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav
 - A Joint collaboration with Ministry of Culture celebrating Amrit Mahotsav
 - A multi stakeholder Amrit Mahotsav event
- II) All events must be powered by an active pre and post event publicity campaign.
- III) All AKAM events must have a press release with some introductory details on AKAM.
- IV) All PIB/State IPR teams - national and local must be briefed about the events.
- V) In social media, all events to carry hashtag #AmritMahotsav.
