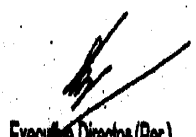

Foot Note No.2. No major penalty shall be imposed by authority subordinate to that by which a person was appointed.

Foot Note No.3. For initiating common proceedings in respect of Class-I and II, approval of Managing Director would be required.
